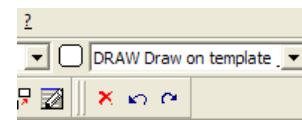
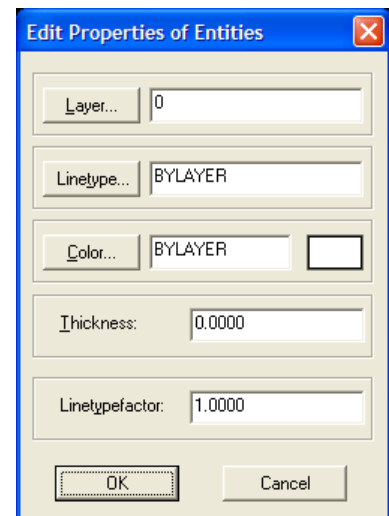

Abstract: AllenCAD 7.0 build 5 has several new features.

- Allows drawing on templates with a new linetype DRAW.
- Allows specifying the units of measure for the drawing.

DRAWING on template

The [CD Copy](#) or [Web Site Copy](#) technical support bulletin describes the process of drawing text using a fiber tipped pen on the template. This new feature allows using the new “DRAW on template” line type two draw centerlines or other objects on the template. To load the draw line type select EDIT -> Modify Object properties, select a line to modify, right click and the Edit properties of Entities box is display. Click on Linetype button, then the Load button. Select either inch or mm files and then select DRAW and click on OK. The new line type will now appear in the line type drop down on the properties tool bar. You can make a new object that you draw to be drawn on the template by selecting the Draw on template from the drop down menu before drawing the lines you want to draw. If you have already created a line you can use the Edit -> Modify object properties to change the line type.



Drawing Units

The tile line options screen now has capability to specify which units of measure inches or mm the drawing being tiled has been drawn. The units originally default to the current units specified in your language options in the system control panel.
